Optional considerations such as staff survey's, mental health training seminars and staff hygiene PPE packs available as required.










#### Plans, discussions and installation.



Ongoing layout amendments and graphic alterations are available during the continuing COVID 19 protocol updates.












Layouts show example open plan office layout. Example client occupies multiple floors within building. Floor area: 10,000 Sq ft










---- Potential graphic locations.


Potential digital locations.




Car parking spaces may need to be increased or reconfigured where possible. Alterations should take into account the possibility of staff preferring to travel by car. Hand sanitiser stations can be located in close proximity parking spaces. Increased cycle racks should also be considered for colleagues who prefer to cycle to the office rather than a short journey on public transport. Hand sanitisers and external lockers could be located in close proximity to cycle zone.


With increased cleaning requirements and potential rota working, colour coded desk mats could be used to indicate which rota is active and if the desk has been deep cleaned since the previous occupant. These simple but effective items may aid with staff comfort level as cleaning protocols are instantly visible.
